NCEMS will be holding an employment test for the positions of part time Lead Paramedic and part time EMT. Successful candidates will serve on an ALS response ambulance providing emergency life support and rescue services to North Clark County, Cowlitz County, and Skamania County.

Applicants must:

1. Be a Nationally Registered Paramedic, Nationally Registered EMT, or be a Washington State certified Paramedic or EMT.
2. Possess a valid motor vehicle operator's license with a driving record sufficiently clear to allow insurability.
3. Successfully complete a comprehensive background investigation.
4. Successfully pass a pre-employment drug screen and physical.
5. Have the physical ability to perform the job as required.
6. Applicants for the Lead Paramedic positions must have a minimum of two years experience as a paramedic in an active EMS system. Paramedic applicants must be currently working full time in an ALS capacity, or have a current part time status with a continuous and lengthy working history.

As part of the selection process applicants can expect to participate in a physical ability assessment, protocol knowledge assessment, and oral interviews.
