NCEMS Part Time Lead Paramedic

Salary Range \$20.42 – 29.18/hr DOE

NCEMS will be holding an employment test February 21st, 2022 for the position of part time Lead Paramedic. This position will serve on an ALS response Ambulance providing emergency life support and rescue services to North Clark County, Cowlitz County, and Skamania County.

Applicants must:

1. Be a Nationally Registered Paramedic, or Washington State certified as a Paramedic.
2. Have a valid motor vehicle operator's license and have a driving record sufficiently clear to allow insurability.
3. Successfully complete a comprehensive background investigation.
4. Successfully pass a pre-employment drug screen and physical.
5. Have the physical ability to perform the job as required.
6. Applicants for the Lead Paramedic positions must have two years experience as a Paramedic. Applicants must be currently working full time in an ALS capacity, or have a current part time status with continuous and lengthy working history preferably in the Clark County EMS system.
7. Covid vaccination is a requirement of employment with NCEMS.

As part of the selection process applicants can expect to participate in a physical ability assessment, protocol knowledge assessment, and oral interviews.
