NCEMS will be holding an employment test November 30th, 2022 to establish a hiring list for part time Lead Paramedics and EMTs. Successful candidates will serve on an ALS response Ambulance providing emergency life support and rescue services to North Clark County, Cowlitz County, and Skamania County.

Applicants must:

1. Be a Nationally Registered Paramedic or EMT, or Washington State certified as a Paramedic or EMT.
2. Have a valid motor vehicle operator's license and have a driving record sufficiently clear to allow insurability.
3. Successfully complete a comprehensive background investigation.
4. Successfully pass a pre-employment drug screen and physical.
5. Have the physical ability to perform the job as required.
6. Applicants for the Lead Paramedic positions must have a minimum of two years experience as a paramedic in an active EMS system. Paramedic applicants must be currently working full time in an ALS capacity, or have a current part time status with continuous and lengthy working history.
7. Covid vaccination is a requirement of employment with NCEMS.

As part of the selection process applicants can expect to participate in a physical ability assessment, protocol knowledge assessment, and oral interviews.
